

## **PRIVACY NOTICE REGARDING THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA**

*(pursuant to Articles 13–14 of EU Regulation No. 679/2016 - concerning the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, as well as the Principle of Accountability)*

The association [VOLONTARIATO TORINO ETS](https://www.volontariatotorino.it/) (hereinafter “VOL.TO”), Volunteer Support Centre, based in Turin, address via Giolitti 21, in its capacity as data controller pursuant to art. 4 EU Reg. n. 679/2016 (hereinafter “controller”) informs you that the personal data you provide will be processed in compliance with the U.E. Reg. n 2016/679 (hereinafter “GDPR 2016/679”).

In particular VOL.TO informs that:

### **1. Object of the processing and purpose of processing:**

The data controller may use the personal data you provide through the EnviRights Platform (<https://envirightsreport.volontariatotorino.it/>) exclusively for the purposes specified within the monitoring system of the EnviRights Project - Empowering Environmental Rights Defenders through Monitoring, Capacity Building, and Advocacy in Europe.

The data being processed consists of personal, identifying, and contact information. Data processing may only take place if subject to prior consent.

The personal data provided will be processed exclusively within the scope of the project’s activities and for purposes strictly related to the project. Specifically, the data will be used to properly manage the organizational, administrative, and operational activities necessary for the project’s implementation.

Data processing will be carried out in accordance with the principles of lawfulness, fairness, and transparency and will be limited to what is necessary to ensure the proper functioning of project activities. No processing will be carried out for purposes other than those indicated above.

### **2. Methods of treatment:**

The Data Controller engages third parties to manage the EnviRights Platform and project-related activities; these third parties process personal data on its behalf and have been appointed as Data Processors pursuant to Article 28 of the GDPR.

In particular, personal data entered as part of reports may be processed by authorized personnel working at the EnviRights project's partner organizations, exclusively for purposes related to the management, evaluation, and handling of reports.

These entities act on the basis of specific instructions provided by the Data Controller and are bound by confidentiality and security obligations.

The organizations designated as Data Processors are as follows:

The personal data processed by the Data Controller will not be disclosed, meaning it will not be made available to unspecified parties in any form, whether through direct access or consultation.

The data will be processed exclusively within the EnviRights Platform and made accessible only to authorized individuals, within the limits of their respective roles.

Any analysis, monitoring, and reporting activities within the EnviRights project will be carried out using aggregated and/or anonymized data, so as not to make the data subjects identifiable.

In any case, the data will not be transferred to organizations operating outside the European Union.

### **3. Personal data retention period**

Personal data will be kept for a period of 5 years starting from the granting of your last consent for the purpose indicated in point 2.

### **4. Rights of the interested party**

Under the GDPR (Regulation (EU) 2016/679), the data subject has the right of access (Art. 15), the right to rectification (Art. 16), the right to erasure (Art. 17), the right to restriction of processing (Art. 18), the right to data portability (Art. 20), the right to object (Art. 21), the right to object to automated decision-making (Art. 22), and the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority of the country of residence (Art. 77).
